4. Creation of a new committee to review RPPTL Section bylaws, with Fletch Belcher to chair.

As reflected in the Financial Summary portion of the Treasurer's Report, Fletcher reported that, as of June 30, 2006, revenue was \$1,055,727.00 (\$216,451.00 of which came from corporate sponsors), expenses were \$867,970.00, net income was \$187,757.00, and the balance on hand was \$448,082.00.

**VIII. Real Property Law Division – John Neukamm, Director.**

**1. Action Item:**

- a. Proposed Construction Lien Law Glitch Bill. Cary Wright, Vice-Chair of the Construction Law Committee presented a glitch bill proposing various changes to the construction lien law statutes to clarify the statutes and to conform them to existing law. The proposed bill was included at pp. 35-58 of the agenda materials. Certain edits to the proposed changes were discussed and accepted. Upon motions duly made by the Construction Law Committee and unanimously carried, the proposed Construction Lien Law Glitch Bill was approved. It was decided that it was within the purview of the Section and that expenditure of Section funds would be authorized to support passage of the proposed Glitch Bill.
- b. Uniform Title Standards Revision to Chapter 8 on Construction Liens. It was included at pages 58-65 in the agenda materials and presented by Pat Jones, Chair of the Uniform Title Standards

Committee. Certain edits to the proposed title standards were discussed and accepted. Upon motion by the Uniform Title Standards Committee, the subject title standards were unanimously approved as modified. The newly adopted standards are to be posted on the Section's website.

- c. Uniform Title Standards Revision to Chapter 13 on Conveyances or Mortgages by or to Trustees—Effect of Designation “Trustee”. It was included at pages 66-70 in the agenda materials and presented by Pat Jones, Chair of the Uniform Title Standards Committee. Certain edits to the proposed title standards were discussed and accepted. Upon motion by the Uniform Title Standards Committee, the subject title standards were unanimously approved as modified. The newly adopted standards are to be posted on the Section's website.
- d. Proposed Rule regarding unprofessional conduct. Materials concerning the proposed rule were set forth in pages 71-77 of the agenda materials. David Garten and Bob Swain, as Chairs of their respective Section Professionalism Committees summarized the proposed rule concerning potential sanctions and fines that may be assessed by a judge for unprofessional conduct by lawyers appearing before the judge. There was much discussion and comments concerning the proposed rule. Any additional comments concerning the proposed rule should be forwarded to David Garten and Bob Swain. The Real Property Professionalism Committee's motion to authorize the Section's Executive Committee to determine and forward to the appropriate parties the Section's response to the proposed rule was passed by majority vote.

- a. John Neukamm presented a short video trailer at the Legislative and Case Law Update Seminar with respect to the Section's 50th anniversary video project. John reported that the final version of the video should be ready by the end of the year. FLSSI was thanked for its financial support for this video project.

## **IX. Probate & Trust Law Division – Sandra F. Diamond, Director.**

### **1. Action Items:**

- a. Guy Emerich, Chair of the Estate and Trust Tax Planning Committee reported on the proposed amendment to Florida

Statutes Chapter 198.13. The legislative proposal (the "Proposal") eliminates the requirement under Section 198.13 of the Florida Statutes of a personal representative of an estate to file a Florida estate tax return with the Florida Department of Revenue if a state death tax credit is not allowable pursuant to the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended from time to time (the "Code") as of the decedent's date of death. In addition, the Proposal eliminates the requirement under Section 198.13 of the Florida Statutes of an individual who would otherwise be responsible for filing a return reporting a generation-skipping transfer with the Florida Department of Revenue if a state generation-skipping transfer tax credit is not allowable pursuant to the Code as of a decedent's date of death. The Proposal does not have a fiscal impact on state funds and was set forth at pages 78-82 of the agenda materials. Upon motion duly proposed and made by the Estate and Trust Planning Committee, by unanimous vote, it was decided to approve the Proposal, that the Proposal was within the purview of the Section, and that funds are authorized to be expended in support of the Proposal.

The Committee is also seeking solutions to the insurance crisis, including premium increases triggering buyers' right to rescind contracts. The Committee is communicating with the Business Law Section concerning a rewrite of the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act with respect to non-charitable 501(c)3 entities, and coordinating with the Title Insurance Committee to address problems with respect to obtaining estoppel letters from associations. Finally, the Committee has scheduled seminars on March 15-16, 2007.
